Administrators and others opposed to our union might speculate that a reduction in the number of graduate students is a possible outcome of unionization. In reality this threat has **no empirical foundation in the experience of universities with unionized grad employees**. Unions of academic researchers and teachers keep administrators accountable and ensure resources are used efficiently for the core purposes of the university.

The bottom line: 

Fifty years of experience shows that a union for grad employees will make Harvard a better university for everyone.
