Unlike at NYU, Harvard’s administrators have refused to consider a neutrality agreement. **Neutrality allows us to decide without pressure.** While attempting to appear even-handed, **administrators are using their authority to skew the conversation.** Faculty have been told to stress the “downsides” of unionization. Deans have disseminated a website filled with speculation meant to cause fear and uncertainty. Grads can see through these tactics. We should be making this decision ourselves, without pressure or misinformation.

The bottom line: 

Harvard has hired anti-union lawyers who are experts in causing uncertainty among employees. The administration should do the right thing and agree to neutrality.
